Inspired with this confidence, I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother. To thee do I come, before thee I kneel, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in thy mercy hear and answer me. Amen.

Rosary of Repentance

Act of Contrition: Oh my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee and I detest all of my sins, because I dread the loss of Heaven and the pains of hell. But most of all, my God, because You are all good and deserving of all my love. And I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace, to confess my sin, to do penance and to amend my life. Amen.

Creed: I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, make of Heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through Him all things were made. For us men and four our salvation he came down from Heaven, (bow) and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man (end bow). For our sake He was crucified under Pontius Pilate, He suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into Heaven and is seated at the right Hand of the Father. He will come to judge the living and the dead and His Kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord the Giver of Life, Who proceeds from the Father and the Son, Who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, Who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy Catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Oh My Jesus:

Oh my Jesus, forgive the sins of , save him from the fires of Hell. Lead his soul into Heaven, especially when he is in most need of Thy mercy. Amen.

Eternal Father, we offer you the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for the soul of and of the whole world.

For the Sake (on Hail Mary beads):

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on the soul of and on the whole world.

Closing Prayer:

Eternal God, in Whom mercy is endless, and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon and upon us, and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments, we may not despair, nor become despondent, but with great confidence, submit to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy Itself. Amen.

Eternal Rest
